

i Important notice to our valued guests about COVID-19

Our job and priority is to keep our guests and staff safe. **Please do not travel if you recently received a positive COVID-19 test result. Tests are available locally on request at the clinic next to SeeCreatures. We highly recommend at least double vaccination for everybody.** More detailed information on our COVID-19 procedures and protocols [here](#).

General Measures

- **We recommend wearing masks in all common areas**
- Complying with standard infection protection and control precautions related to hygiene:
 - Hand-washing using the 20-second rule with hot water and soap.
 - Use of hand sanitizer
 - Avoid touching your face, particularly your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands to prevent infection
 - Cough/sneeze into the bend of your elbow with your mask on
 - If you use a tissue, discard it properly and wash and sanitize your hands.

Pre-boarding Guidelines: before you leave your place of residence

- Be sure you are healthy before leaving to travel to join us at the camp.
- Inform us if you have tested positive for COVID-19 or show any symptoms before leaving to the camp.
- Make arrangements to bring the necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) sufficient to cover the period of travel to the camp.

Practices while at the airport/on the aircraft:

- Wear PPE as instructed for the duration of travel as far as practicable (e.g. mask and gloves, etc.)
- Carry and handle your own luggage to the extent possible.
- Keep all relevant documents required for travel in a bag or compartment that can be easily accessed and disinfected later.

Local hotel stay:

- Pay attention to any social distancing, hygiene and PPE requirements at the hotel.
- Continue to handle your own luggage at the hotel.
- Consider declining daily room cleaning service.

Prior to traveling to our camp:

- Properly dispose of any single-use PPE used during travel (only that which cannot be washed/disinfected).
- We will arrange for disinfection of your luggage and dive gear at SeeCreatures San José del Cabo.

At the camp:

- Practice self-distancing that include:
 - **We recommend wearing masks in all common areas**
 - All spaces at the camp, including your tent, will have been disinfected with vital oxide application by fogging machines
 - Crew assistance with buffet meal service and drinks
